Executive Director Updates

Resident Referral Program

We are piloting a new program to incentivize a resident for referring a friend to live here. Whether it's a resident, or a resident's family/friend, we will give \$100 rent credit for any referral starting today. The referral has to be someone qualified to live in our community. Please reach out to Geoff Nese or Krista Monahan if you have any questions on qualifications. Take advantage of this great program!

Delta Variant- COVID 19

Many of you have read about the rise in Covid cases due to the Delta variant, and naturally, you have questions. Here are a few key facts about this variant of concern:

- Delta is transmitted at more than twice the rate of the "original" coronavirus. Last year, a positive individual would pass the disease to 2.5 people. With Delta, that number averages more than 5 people infected for each positive individual
- Someone positive for Delta generates 1,000 times <u>more</u> viral material than an individual who tested positive with last year's coronavirus
- The Delta variant can be transmitted by a vaccinated <u>or</u> unvaccinated individual

... the good news:

- The vaccine is nearly 100% effective at preventing serious injury or death from Covid/Delta
- You are 8 times less likely to contract Covid (or Delta) if you are vaccinated!

While most residents and associates are vaccinated, we must do everything we can to protect those among us who are unable to be vaccinated or have compromised health conditions. The Delta variant is the most serious version of Covid that we've faced, and its prevalence in the broader community is higher than at any time during this pandemic. For these reasons, we urge all residents (vaccinated or not) to wear masks when out of your apartment. While none of us enjoy wearing masks, the truth is, this is the most effective action we can take to protect each other.

One additional request regarding critical service providers that many of you utilize (Hospice, Home Health, Personal Care Aides, etc). It is critical that these individuals be vaccinated for everyone's protection. The choice to use these services is yours, as is your prerogative to require that these service providers only send vaccinated individuals to assist. Please have a conversation with these agencies to ensure that they only send vaccinated individuals into our community.

Visiting Guests

All Guests visiting Woodbridge Terrace are required to be vaccinated for COVID-19. If you choose to come visit your loved ones within our community and have been vaccinated, we ask that present your vaccination card at the front desk and a copy will be made for our records. Another option if you have not been vaccinated is to take a COVID-19 test. Once you receive your negative results you have a 24-hour window to visit. If you choose not to share your vaccination records you can still visit outside in our front patio. Assisted Living and Memory Care Update From Terrie and Matthew

Podiatry Services- Dr. Luke Won is providing services for our residents on the first and third Wednesday of every month. For AL residents please sign up at the mail room signup sheet if you would like to be seen by the podiatrist. For MC residents, families reach out to Matthew for scheduling. For more information please contact Jackie or Matthew.

Synergy Lab- If you have an order for X-Ray, Echocardiogram, EKG, Ultrasound or Doppler. Please send the order to Matthew or Terrie to schedule the technician to come out for services. Kaiser approves of this vendor for services. All we need is an order from the doctor.

Dr. Casey Goodman- If you need to be seen by a physician. Dr. Goodman is able to do medication reconciliation, chronic disease management, order labs in house and partners with outside home health agencies and hospice for further medical support. Please reach out to Matthew or Terrie if you are interested in having him follow you as the resident or the loved one looking for a new provider.

Lab Services- Terrie and I are still working on finalizing a partnership with a lab to be done in house. (More to come at the end of July-beginning August).

Top Optician- Currently speaking with a provider to provide vision checks and need for corrective lenses. Should your loved one need an ophthalmologist for cataracts, macular degeneration or eye health checkups, they can assist with referring to the nearest one.

Dr. BJ Adrezin and Dr. Yul Rapoport- They are our neurologists that will be providing services for our residents in house. At the time they will be conducting tele medicine appointments until their census builds and once the resident is established they are able to conduct testing for sensitivity of medication through

genetic testing via mouth swab, EEGs, and Extensive Neurocognitive examinations. They focus on resident with Dementia, Parkinson's Disease, MCI and etc. For more information please reach out to Matthew.

Enable Dentist- They will be coming the Third Thursday of every month to provide cleaning services, dental check-ups and any other dental needs. For additional information or wanting to sign up please reach out to Terrie and Matthew.

Clear Choice Hearing Company- They will be coming the third Wednesday of every other month in the Arts & Craft Room at 2PM. They will start August 18, 2021 and see residents every other month. For AL residents the signup sheet is in the mail room. For MC residents, families reach out to Matthew for scheduling. They provide free hearing screenings, cleaning and service of current hearing aids.

ONR In-House Therapy- We are working on setting up rehab in our community to provide for our residents 5 days a week. They provide PT, OT & ST that will be provided in the community for the residents. More to come as we get closer to finalizing a partnership.

Aging Care Wheelchair Tune Up-Service that is provided to make adjustments on power wheelchairs, scooters or manual wheelchair adjustments. Medicare equipment benefits updated. Working on finalizing this partnership.

Three more future partnerships coming out in the next couple of months.

COVID-19 Orange County Numbers

There are 269,016 cumulative cases confirmed (4,389,948 tested) with currently 454 hospitalized and 71 in ICU. These numbers are alarming and nearly doubled since last week. Please wear your mask around others to keep yourself safe. Currently, Orange County is at a 7.99% positivity rate. Thankfully, 252,473 people have recovered so far.
