Kisco Spirit Scholarship Frequently Asked Questions

- **Who is eligible for the Kisco Spirit Scholarship?**

Current, retired, and former Kisco senior living associates, their spouses, or children as well as residents of the local cities where we serve.

- **How do I apply for the Kisco Spirit Scholarship Fund?**

Eligible applicants are invited to submit applications two times per year, outlining their course of study, relevant background information, a personal statement of goals and motivation, two letters of recommendation to support their application, and proof of tuition for their course of study. - **When can you apply for the scholarship?**

The scholarship application period is in the Spring and Fall for the next school semester.

- **What is the dollar amount that I can apply?**

When applying, applicants must indicate the exact cost of the course they are applying for based on the tuition for professional school (trade/vocational), GED programs or for higher education institutions. (Maximum grant is \$5,000 per year)

- **Who can be a reference for me?**

You must submit two references for your application to be considered for the scholarship. One reference should be from your current supervisor if employed and one a personal reference. If not employed, please provide two personal references.

- **What does the scholarship cover?**

The Kisco Spirit Scholarship covers **tuition cost only** and must be used in the semester that the applicant has applied. Scholarship funds do not transfer to other schools and will not be carried over to the next semester.
