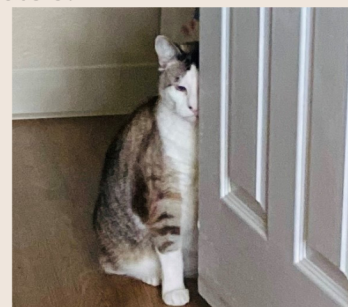
Tweetie Pie, although about the same weight, has an adorable face. She knows it and acts like a spoiled beauty.

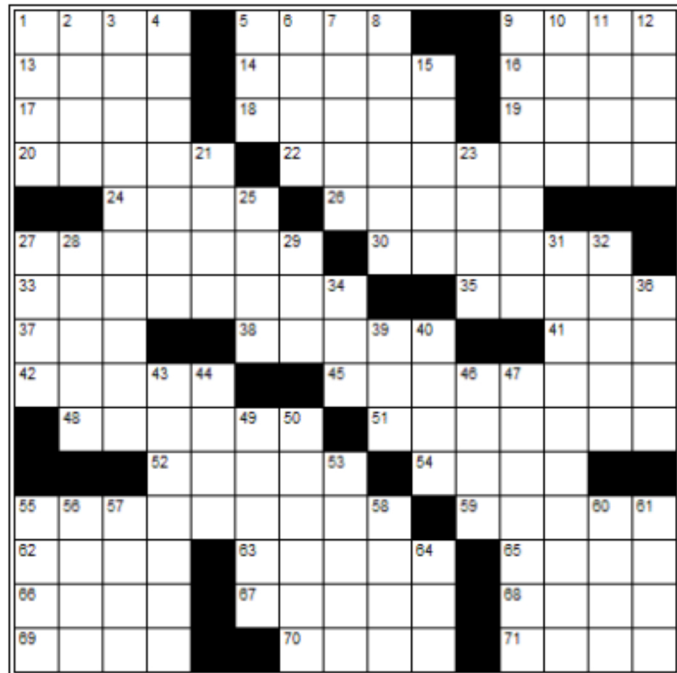
